I know you hate reading emails. I thought about calling you. But, it seems difficult to carry on any sort of <u>serious</u> "father/son" talks on a phone now days. So, hopefully, you will take this one for what it's worth. Try to understand that I'M VERY WORRIED... for you, Molly, Darryn, anyone living in North America, et al. It's not the end of the world... yet. **But, bear with me.** 

There are 3 or 4 **MAJOR** things I'm worried about (I'll get to them below). But first a bit of history or a refresher course of sorts.

My entire 69 year long life **we**, as a family (my dad, mom, grandparents, and even you boys while growing up), went through some strange times – up and downs, so to speak. But there always seemed to be some light at the end of each tunnel. Overall, living in the USA was about as good as it gets. Land of the free, home of the brave, etc. Most folks were patriotic and there was far less division vs. now days. We **lived** (pass tense) in a FREE WORLD; while I was growing up. There were communists running around, but far less than, say, the 1%. Mom and dad could get a job just about any time they wanted to. If they worked hard they could earn enough to get by and put food on the table. They never had to file bankruptcy, or give their home back to the bank, etc. (like folks had to back in the depression... or...). The same was true **for most of us** up through about 2005. Earning a decent living was possible for even a single earner family. And being married was the norm vs. the problem it is now days (1970's onward anyway). You got paid pretty good and you could afford a home and a car, or two, and pay the bills and put food on the table and take a trip once in a while and, for the most part, someone who was considered "middle class" had a pretty safe, secure, happy life to lead.

And GOVERNMENT, per se, wasn't nearly as corrupt as it is now days.

Now, don't get me wrong. There were times when mom and dad (your grandparents) had to struggle through the depression when they were growing up. And dad did have to go fight in Korea and nearly die in that war.

And everyone knows what a fuck fest the Vietnam war was (which I luckily did not get drafted for) and how all the libtard communists protested that war. First they killed Kennedy (1963); so LBJ could do everything possible to get our troops killed; vs winning that war (1964/65, when I was 10, to 1973, my 1st yr @ 19 in college). And, BTW, if I were you (and considering you have a lot more storage space to use and debt racked up than we do), I'd strongly think about building up a supply of as much **canned food** as you can afford. If work goes south and income goes with it, or you tap out your savings (if any), and you can't keep up on your house payments, and you can't sell it (like what happened back in 2008+), at least you can pack a trailer full of non-perishable food and get by for a while. It is very possible another full on depression and chaos is right around the corner. Hopefully it won't get that bad. But it has before and it can again. So, think about it and try your best to <u>plan for the worst</u>... while you hope/pray for the best.
